Therapy Animal Skills Training Workshop

Prerequisites:

- Must have completed the Pet Partner Therapy Animal Workshop or be a registered PP Team.
- Handlers must be willing to have fun and work hard.
- Written consent must be given for children under the age of 18. Children must be at least 10 years of age & accompanied by an adult.
- Dogs/cats must be at least 1 year old prior to their evaluation date.
- Dogs/cats must be current on vaccinations.
- **Dogs must have their Canine Good Citizen certificate.**
- **Dogs must be calm around other animals. (cats, rabbits, mini horses...may attend the workshop)**

At the end of this workshop, you will:

- You and your therapy animal will have the skills you need to make your visits meaningful to the people you visit.
- You will have practiced the skills you and your therapy animal need to pass the Pet Partners Skills and Aptitude Tests
- Know your therapy animal's signs of stress and what to do to relieve that stress.
